



Freelance Practitioner – ‘Your Voice’ Project

Creative Crieff is recruiting for a freelance workshop leader who has significant experience in facilitating creative and digital projects within a care home setting and delivering activity sessions with residents. The successful applicant will aid the team in the design and delivery of an exciting new programme ‘Your Voice’, beginning with a pilot project, which will be rolled out to all care homes in Strathearn and Strathallan over the next 12 months. The project, funded by SCVO Digital Participation Fund, will engage the senior community in care homes with Radio Earn – a brand new community radio station initiative by Creative Crieff. The focus of the project is to facilitate sessions developing skills in digital technology and to participate in the local community radio initiative. The freelance practitioner will work closely with Creative Crieff’s team to ensure the delivery of a high quality co-designed offer for each care home, and the development of long-term partnerships.

Essential:

- Significant experience working with staff and residents in care homes
- Expertise in designing and delivering high quality creative music / digital projects
- Must be able to work effectively with a wider team to co-design and deliver complex workshops
- Ability to effectively evaluate projects with a wider team and perform skills audits throughout the project to track participant progress
- Our care homes are difficult to access via public transport, therefore you will hold a full clean driving license and have access to a car

- Experience in working with digital tablets and recording software
- Experience working with people with dementia
- PVG certificate working with vulnerable adults
